Yard waste: small yard waste is measured as 2-4 cubic feet. Anything larger will be picked up on Saturdays after Resident notification.

Recycle containers can be purchased at Walmart, Home Depot, or Lowe's.

Your household waste should be put out to the street in trash receptacles. Please refrain from setting trash in plastic trash bags overnight on the street for pick up.
