Guest passes are available at the front desk. Passes are a \$5.00 refundable deposit per guest up to \$20.00 maximum deposit. Deposit returned when passes are returned within 3 days of pass expiration date. Resident must be with guests while they are at the pool.

#### **POOL RULES**

Must be in possession of a Resident or Guest Badge Pools open at 8am.

Both pools close at dusk.

The only approved flotation device is a pool noodle. There are NO GLASS CONTAINERS allowed at either pool.

No drinks or drink containers are allowed in the pool. Keep all shoes and personal possessions out of the Safe Zone around the Pool. (Red Line).

Please rinse off before entering pool.

No diapers or pull-ups are allowed in guest pool.

THE GOLF COURSE: at Spanish Lakes Fairways is restricted to Park approved RESIDENT OWNERS, ONLY. No Visitors, No Children. This area is reserved for our Resident golfers only and is not a playground. Golf carts and motorized vehicles of any type are not allowed on the golf course. There is no fishing allowed in the golf course lakes.

# SERVICE DEPARTMENT

**DOG WALKING, PETS:** It is illegal to tie up a dog outdoors unless a guardian is outside along with the dog. Pets are only allowed in the areas designated for them, with the exception of those with support animal training. (Not a vest from the internet). As a resident you are required to walk your pet in his/her yard on a leash. You must remove your pet's waste and dispose of it properly. The ONLY dog walk within the community starts at the dog park and runs south along I-95 side of Spanish Lakes Blvd. to Nuevo Lagos. Dogs should be walked on your own lot or transported to the dog walking area. Please continue to be vigilant in cleaning up at the dog walk and on your lot. DO NOT let your pet defecate on your neighbor's yard. Report violators with pictures and names if possible. Please be a responsible pet owner.

**FEEDING BIRDS AND ANIMALS**: There are many state laws in Florida regarding the feeding of wild animals and birds. These laws are designed to protect the animals from the humans. Some birds like the Cranes cannot digest bird seed but many of us see wings and feed it to them anyway. Leaving seed and

bread around for birds and ducks attract mice, rats, and racoons. We do not need these critters around our homes. Please be respectful of your neighbors as well as the animals.

**ODD** address - Wednesday & Saturday, 6am to 8am and 4pm to 6pm

**EVEN** address - on Thursday & Sunday. 6am to 8am and 4pm to 6pm.

Sprinkler systems of ANY type are NOT permitted.

#### HOUSEHOLD WASTE: !!! NEW !!!

Yes, there was a change in our waste pick up. A big thank you to the residents who told me about this. This new information was verified with Waste Pro on March 13, 2023.

#### **MONDAYS:**

Household and Recycled waste will be picked up EVERY MONDAY.

Recycle collection: recyclables can be co-mingled in your receptacle. There is no need to sort your recyclables.

#### 1st and 3rd MONDAYS:

Yard waste: small yard waste is measured as 2-4 cubic feet.

Large Yard Waste and Large Household Items: will be picked up <u>after Resident notification</u>. Allow 3 to 10 days for pick up.

Recycle containers can be purchased at Walmart, Home Depot, or Lowe's.

Your household waste should be put out to the street in trash receptacles. Please refrain from setting trash in plastic trash bags overnight on the street for pick up.
